Plus, your child's key person will also work closely with you to mirror the potty training routine you use at home.

Our staff, many with Early Years Teacher Status and qualified up to degree level, follow the key areas of the Early Years Foundation Stage. You can expect your child's week to be full of learning experiences, split between the Pre-School, the garden or in the local community.

We use 'planning in the moment', this concept supports child-led learning allowing our practitioners to seize the moments when children first show curiosity and support their next steps immediately. This sustains higher levels of well-being and involvement for the children in our settings, encouraging them to have a 'can do' attitude, critically think and be creative.
