We have nurtured a caring and stimulating environment within all of our Baby and Pre-Toddler Rooms. Using movement, sound, colour and touch, babies and toddlers are encouraged to explore, develop and above all, enjoy their 'second home'.

We strive to complement the childcare that you give your child at home including feeding habits, nappy changes and sleep routines; all made possible through regular contact with your child's experienced key person.

More structured than the Baby Rooms, each varied activity in the Toddler Rooms is considered a learning opportunity and above all, fun and stimulating.

Toddlers are encouraged to enjoy early maths, develop their language skills, undertake creative play and learn to relax at story-time.

Your child's key person will also work closely with you to complement the potty training routine you use at home.



Our aim within every one of our Pre-Schools is to ensure that your child is ready for mainstream school.

Our staff, many with Early Years Teacher Status and qualified up to degree level, follow the key areas of the Early Years Foundation Stage. You can expect your child's time to be full of learning experiences, split between the Pre-School, the garden or in the local community.

We implement 'planning in the moment', this concept supports child-led learning allowing our practitioners to seize the moments when children first show curiosity and supports their learning immediately. This sustains higher levels of well-being and involvement for the children in our settings, encouraging them to have a 'can do' attitude, think critically and be creative.

Whilst we hate to say goodbye when children leave to start school, we ensure that it is undertaken in style with a fun and exciting graduation ceremony. It is a lovely occasion for all of the family to enjoy and includes a graduation service (complete with little gowns and hats), a children's concert service
